Dear Friends of BLOOM,

As we close the chapter on 2023, I'm filled with gratitude—for your unwavering support, for the lives we've touched together, and for the road ahead as we expand our mission and scale to reach even more children in need.

This past year marked a turning point for BLOOM Charity. We reorganized our Board of Directors and strengthened our leadership practices, laying a strong foundation for sustainable growth. These internal shifts were driven by a single goal: to deepen our impact for the most vulnerable children in the world.

While our roots remain strong in Morocco—where we continue to build our healing PlayGardens and provide culturally sensitive support for children living in orphanages—we are now actively growing beyond borders. BLOOM has evolved into a global nonprofit organization serving not just orphans, but vulnerable children everywhere. And we've broadened our scope to include food security and access to education, while staying grounded in our original focus on mental health and early childhood development.

In Fall 2023, when a devastating earthquake struck Morocco, we provided immediate aid to impoverished children and families in crisis. With urgency and compassion, we supplied food and warm clothing, relocated displaced students to a tent school, and began rebuilding the damaged school building.

In December, BLOOM expanded even further, launching mental health and psychosocial support programs for Palestinian children in crisis. These initiatives are a testament to BLOOM's growing global footprint and our commitment to providing healing, hope, and support to children in some of the world's most challenging areas.

This transformation reflects the heartbeat of BLOOM: love in action, dignity at the center, and the belief that every child deserves the chance to thrive.

None of this would be possible without you. Your generosity has allowed us to nurture not only the children we serve, but the very future of our organization. Thank you for planting the seeds of love with us—and for continuing to help them grow.

OUR JOURNEY AT A GLANCE

2017 - BLOOM launched as a 501(c)3, began pilot PlayGarden in Meknes, Morocco and educated staff to be trauma - informed. BLOOM begins Enrichment work in the orphanages to engage community partners and provide more learn through play and play therapy opportunities to children.

2018/2019 - BLOOM builds about two PlayGardens per year, hosts Enrichment Programs for orphans and advocates for their mental health & care

2020/2021 - Ghassani Hospital Orphanage PlayGarden built. Morocco's first handicap accessible playground built, BLOOM supports & advocates for orphans throughout COVID.

2022 - A MILESTONE YEAR - 5 years of BLOOM! PlayGardens completed at orphanages in Errachidia & girl's prphanage in Casablanca, Morocco. Sports area and lockroom built in Essaouira, Morocco orphanage.

2023 - BLOOM is developing a robust leadership team to implement an expanded mission as a global NFP.

BLOOM did not complete a PlayGarden Project in 2023. We focused on building our teams and strengthening operations, enrichment and education programs for vulnerable children, and launched a new program for children in crisis. BLOOM also supported a school community with meals, shelter, and clothing, and helped rebuild their school in the earthquake impacted village of Kettou, Morocco.

ENRICHMENT WORK 2023



- 28 biycles donated & lessons provided to children in Annour orphanage
- Nutritional food, shelter, & educator's salary provided for impoverished students impacted by earthquake - rebuilding school that was destroyed in earthquake.
- Art/play therapy & sports programs provided in Morocco & Gaza
- Holiday outfits, dinners & celebrations hosted in orphanages.
- Palestinian children in US for medical treatment supported with educational materials & mental health programs.
